

#### **Trick-or-Treating**

On the evening of October 31st, people, mostly excited young children in costume, are out in the neighbourhoods trick or treating. The Canadian Red Cross shares these Halloween safety tips to ensure a fun and safe trick-or-treating night.

#### Trick-or-Treating Tips

- Children should stay on sidewalks—walking, not running
- Plan a trick-or-treat route ahead of time and ensure kids follow one side of the street before crossing to the other.
- Cross the street only at intersections or crosswalks.
  Remind kids to look both ways for cars, trucks, and the occasional low-flying broomstick.
- Carry a flashlight to help see and be seen by others.

#### **Costume Safety**

- Choose light-coloured, flame-resistant costumes with reflective strips
- Make sure costumes are short enough to prevent tripping
- Add reflective tape to bikes, skateboards, and brooms
- · Avoid costumes with masks or items that obstruct vision
- Steer clear of open flames and candles as costumes can be highly flammable
