
Here are vital details regarding the convocation:

- There is **no fee** for the ceremony itself, and the **school will provide the gowns and caps.** However, there will be a fee for graduation photos. We will share the final details about this soon.
- If you enrolled between the May 2023 intake and the April 2024 intake and have received a program completion email from us, this confirms your eligibility for the convocation.

March 21 is the International Day for the Elimination of Racial Discrimination. This day commemorates the Sharpeville Massacre in South Africa on March 21, 1960, where sixtynine (69) people were killed during a peaceful protest against apartheid laws. The United Nations declared this day to reinforce the global commitment to eliminating racial discrimination.

It highlights the injustices and prejudices fueled by racial discrimination that occur daily. Governments, organizations, and individuals worldwide come together to promote equality, raise awareness, and celebrate the contributions of marginalized communities.
