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International Day of Education: Celebrating Pathways to Opportunity at ACE Career College



Valedictorian Application Process

Each year, the college recognizes outstanding graduates who embodies academic excellence, leadership, and community involvement. Students who have demonstrated exceptional performance throughout their program are invited to apply for the position of Valedictorian.



What You Need to Do

Exemplary candidates with a 4.0 GPA are eligible to apply. These students will receive an official letter from the Administration Office, along with the Valedictorian Application Form and a complete list of requirements.

Eligible students must prepare and submit the following documents: *Cover letter expressing interest in the valedictorian role, updated resume, records of community service or volunteer work, completed application form, and a letter of recommendation.*

All application materials must be submitted to the Administration Office on or before 17 April 2026.

The valedictorian selection process highlights not only academic achievement but also character, service, and the ability to represent the graduating class with pride. Students who meet the criteria are encouraged to apply and highlight their accomplishments.

Winter Safety Reminders



For Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba

Winter across the Prairie provinces is known for extreme cold, icy roads, and sudden weather changes. It is a season of contrasts – mild stretches one-week, sharp cold snaps the next, and the classic Prairie snowfall throughout. As you plan your commute, classes, and daily routines, keep yourself safe and prepared with these essential reminders.

Helpful Tips for the Season

Dress for the Weather

- Layer up with thermal clothing.
- Wear insulated, slip-resistant boots.
- Protect exposed skin to prevent frostbite.
- Choose windproof outerwear for harsh wind chills.

Safe Commuting and Walking

- Check weather & road conditions before heading out.
- Allow extra travel time during snow or freezing rain.
- Use cleared, salted walkways
- Walk slowly & carefully on icy surfaces

Stay Informed

- Monitor Environment Canada alerts.
- Watch for extreme cold warnings and blizzard advisories.
- Keep your phone charged in case of delays or emergencies

Protect yourself from Extreme Cold

- Limit time outdoors during severe cold snaps.
- Take warm-up breaks if walking long distances.
- Know the signs of frostbite and hypothermia

Vehicle Safety (If You Drive)

- Keep an Emergency Kit (blanket, flashlight, snacks, booster cables, etc.)
- Ensure winter tires are installed and properly inflated.
- Keep your gas tank at least half full
- Clear snow and ice from all windows before driving
